CRSI Project

- Evaluation of ACT Parenting Program
- Understand if timeframe of open CPS case impacted program completion
- Mixed Methods Design: De-identified data & 2 class sessions
- Findings: Parents w/cases 0-3 months most likely to graduate
- Parents with substance abuse and mental health were least likely to graduate
- Informed agency of supports to provide (Motivational interviewing/referrals/case plan review) to program participants

Current Research: STARR – Surviving Trauma and Reaching Resilience

- Domestic Violence Education Group
- Partnership with CWRU Psychology Dept.
- Mixed Methods Design
- 42 Participants
- Results: Both feasible and acceptable to group members
- Program participation associated with reductions in depression, anxiety, and in exposure to domestic violence.
